



Advanced Practice Provider Fellowship in Oncology & BMT

The Oncology/BMT APP Fellowship is being offered to Physician Assistants and Nurse Practitioners through Seattle Cancer Care Alliance and its Alliance partners: Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center and the University of Washington.

This paid one year comprehensive experience will afford the opportunity to participate in one of two tracks: Medical Oncology or Stem Cell Transplant. The program has two start dates: October 1, 2018 and January 2, 2019.

Benefits include a stipend of \$80k/year, medical and dental benefits, and CME support

Applications are due by February 23, 2018.

The application packet will include:

- Personal statement of interest
- Curriculum Vitae
- Unofficial transcripts from PA or NP program
- Two reference letters from clinical peer or supervisor
 - If less than two years of experience, one letter is needed from Program Director

Application packets are due no later than February 23, 2018 and should be sent electronically to:

Candidate interviews will take place in early April, followed by notification of accepted candidates by May 1st

Applicant qualifications

- Current student or graduate of an accredited PA or NP Program
- Baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university; a clinical/health-oriented masters degree is preferred
- PAs must have passed or be eligible to take the NCCPA Examination
- Adult, FNP, or Acute Care Nurse Practitioners must have passed or be eligible to take the AANP or ANCC certification examination
- Obtain licensure in the state of Washington prior to the program start date
- Eligible for medical staff privileges and faculty appointment
