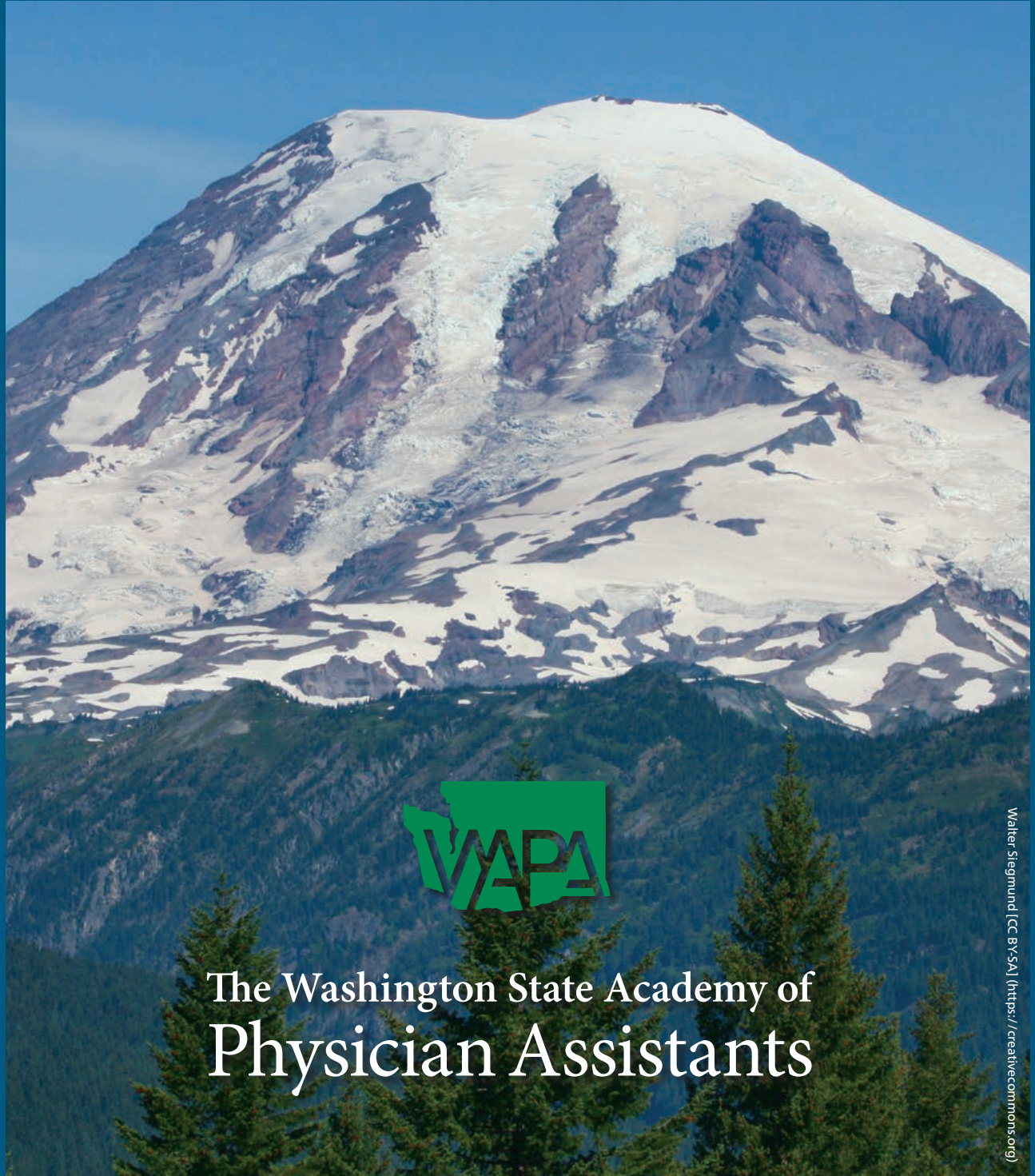


# 31st Annual Primary Care Review and Update 2020 Spring Conference

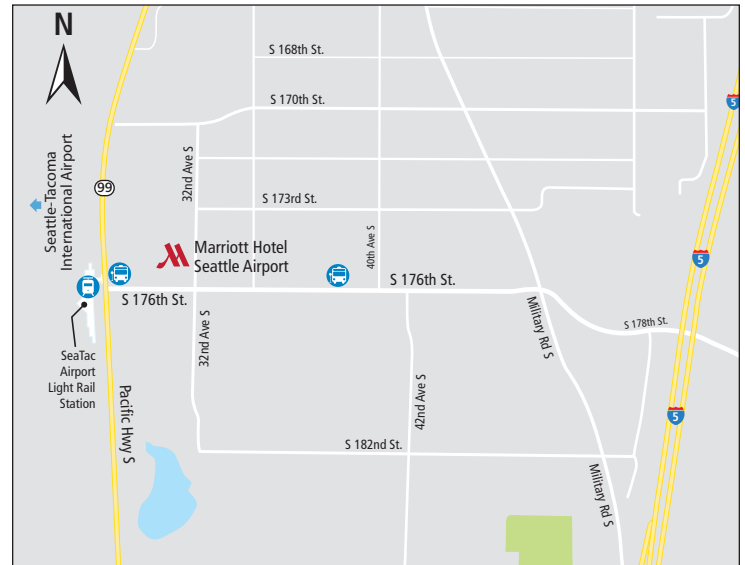
